1. Bob Agate provided the following comments:

 - b. Encouraged members to practice good etiquette (sanding divots, raking traps, fixing ball marks on the greens)
 - c. Next weeks game
 - d. MGA membership at ~ 165 members, ~ 200 expected by early 2026

3. Head Golf Professional Bruce Harris provided:
 - a. Results of the days game
 - b. Pro Shop/Handicap Committee use of the Cap Patrol system (eg., used for auto posting reminder emails)
 - c. Pro Shop/Handicap Committee standard for playing in club events (minimum of 60% of scores must be posted)
 - d. Improvements seen in overall club posting percentage
 - e. Options for balls hit close to OB boundaries near homes (eg., holes 1 and 6), details communications have been sent out by the Pro Shop.
 - f. During Bruce's handicap discussion, Bob Agate noted that the MGA will be adopting a 60% posting rule, details being discussed with MGA Board.
 - g. Bruce noted that options for dealing with the new flagsticks is under discussion.

5. Bob Agate announced that JB Belknap will be the guest speaker at the Dec meeting.
