Topics of Discussion:

1. Next Tuesday (1/14) is the MGA Membership Meeting.
 - The MGA will provide pizza and beer.
 - Tim Kortanek will be our guest speaker, some of the questions to be presented to Tim are:
 - a. Can the green speed be posted each day?
 - b. What can be done to provide more consistency to the sand traps?
 - c. Can anything be done to firm up the soft areas in front of the greens?
 - d. Is the weekly designation of a cart path only hole necessary / are there any observed benefits?
2. Current Membership / New Members:
 - Bill Harville noted that the MGA currently has 206 members.
 - There are currently 29 new members for this season. Bill Paris will continue to contact new members and review Chelsea System and Golf Genius app with them, as well as presenting each of them with the MGA welcome towel package.

3. Golf Committee:
 - Bob Regnier stated that there was no new business from the last golf committee meeting. The next golf committee meeting is on Monday 1/13, the MGA board provided the following questions for Bob to bring up at the meeting:
 - a. There are currently no OB or hazard stakes down the west side of hole 3, will stakes be put back to identify the area as either out of bounds or a hazard?
 - b. The cart path area on hole 18 is compacted and very hard for a waste area, can a player get relief from this area like they would a paved/concrete cart path?

4. Miscellaneous:

- The MGA will provide a \$500 for a hole in one prize pool for Hole 11 in the Member/Guest tournament.
- Bill Harville will order 100 magnetic ball marks to be given out this year to individuals who donate \$30 to the Veterans of the Glen fund raiser this spring

- The MGA will donate \$100 to sponsor a hole for the Pretty in Pink tournament.
